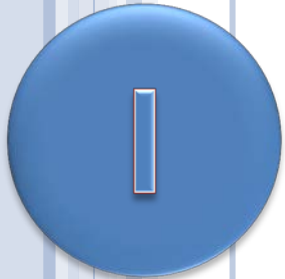

ADVANTAGES OF USING AIM IN PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING PRACTICE

- Process-oriented
- Content-free
- Use in any health care setting with any client
- Focuses on interplay of various systems
- Participation of community client in shared decision-making process

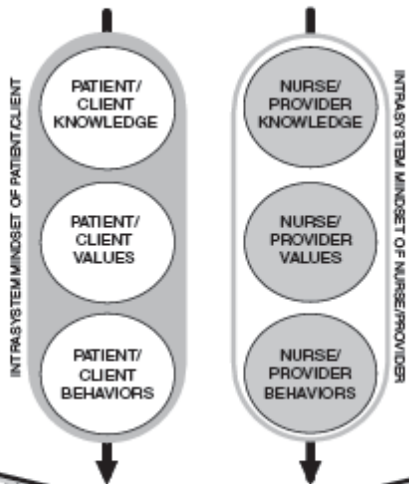

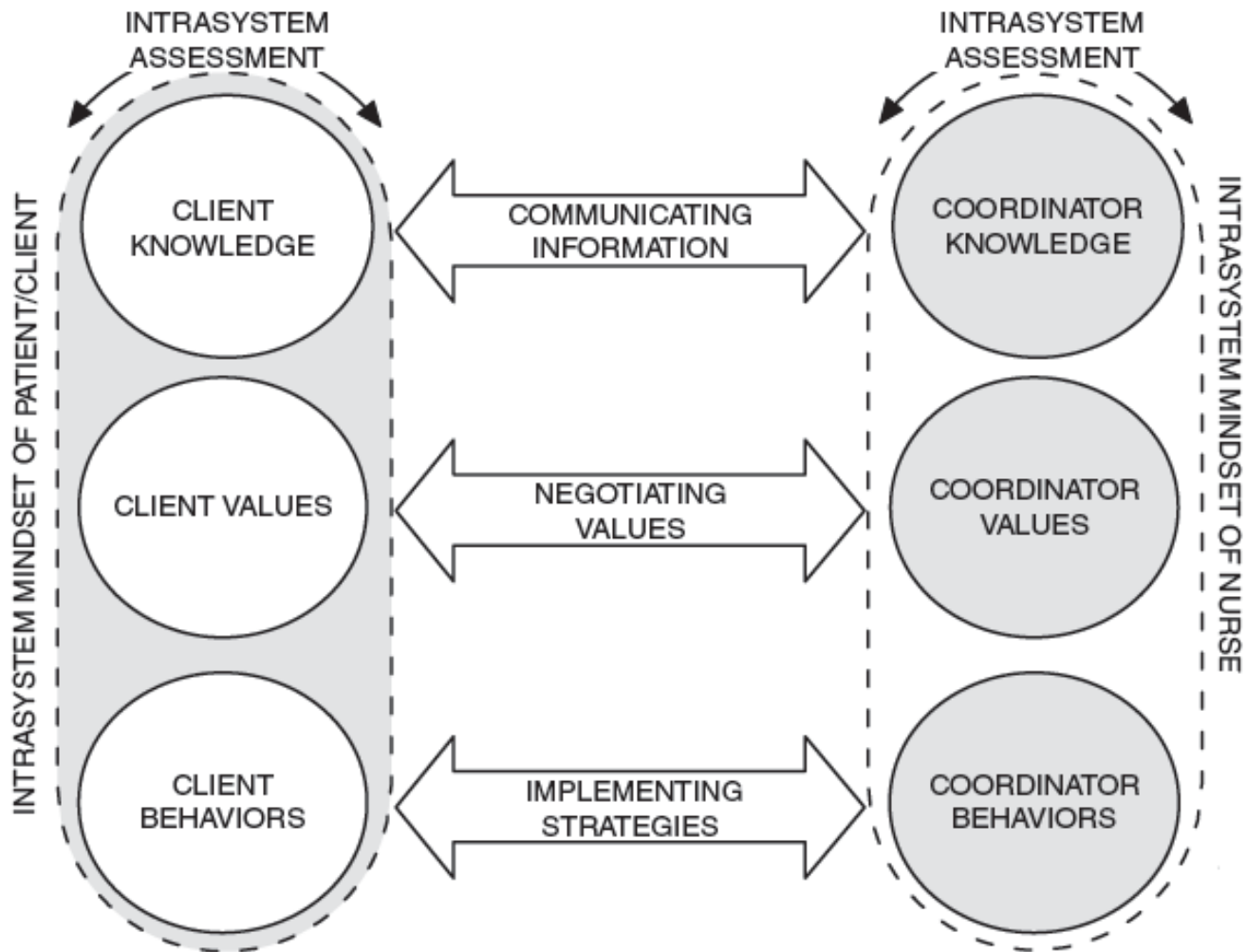
Analysis of Intrasystem Information by Nurse

- Identify stressors
- Identify coping resources of patient
- Score Situational Sense of Coherence (SSOC)
- State nursing diagnosis/es
- Identify goals to increase SSOC
- Assess ability of patient & nurse to resolve Main Concern together
